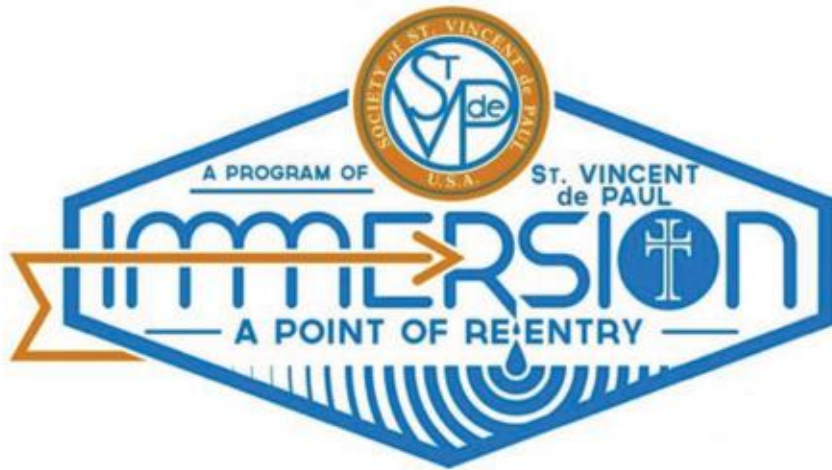

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The IMMERSION Reentry Program has been designed by the Society of St. Vincent de Paul USA (SVdP) to serve as a continuous improvement national model reentry program focusing on the special needs and challenges of returning citizens – those returning to our communities from incarceration. This specific “at risk” group, “at risk” to re-offend, and their families, comprise about one-third of those neighbors in need that SVdP helps daily throughout the country in our efforts to provide a “helping hand” lift out of poverty.

We believe that poverty is a term that is not only defined in terms of financial well-being, but also a term that can reflect a variety of conditions to include lack of spiritual and social well-being, lack of healthy relationships, lack of adequate support system, and lack of adequate access to resources needed to navigate the roadblocks to self-sufficiency.

Our goal is to provide a welcoming network of support and wrap-around services to returning citizens and their families and loved ones in navigating the unique challenges they face, assisting them in accessing resources that may otherwise seem to be unavailable to those sincerely interested in a positive and productive return to their communities.

While many Governmental, secular non-profits, and religious agencies also focus on reentry, few have the National reach, scope, and wrap-around services capacity that SVdP is capable of providing, such as food, clothing and furniture pantries, continuing education, financial assistance, mentors, partnerships and collaboration with other like-minded community agencies, and much more.

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul is an equal opportunity service provider. Services at each site is not standardized around the country but our Vincentians, staff and volunteer members, provide services as best they can with the resources at their disposal. Not all sites are designated IMMERSION© sites, nor provide all services listed above. Please check which services are available in your locality. IMMERSION© sites are listed on this website. ANSWERS TO FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Do you have housing for Men and Women? Yes. Houses are gender specific. A variety of housing options are available from shared apartments with smaller groups of 2 per unit, larger duplexes with 6-8 residents, single family homes with 8-12 residents and the Rising Sun Inn with a larger group, including 8 private rooms. Male facilities are offered in Boise, Caldwell, Lewiston, Twin Falls and Idaho Falls. Female facilities are offered in Boise, Caldwell, Lewiston, and Pocatello.
 - Is there a time requirement to remain in housing? Not beyond the first month. Residents can remain in housing until they feel ready to transition out with approval by probation and parole.
 - What is the cost? The first month is \$450 and reduces to \$400/month beginning second month.
 - Can I pay weekly, bi-weekly or on my pay periods? Yes, except for the 1st month.
 - How do I pay first month's rent to insure a bed is available upon my release? There are several options. Family member can make the payment on-line by visiting our website, payments can be made in person at the Main Office between 8-5pm M-F. Money orders or cash only. Payments can also be mailed to main office. If you do not have funds for your first month's rent, ask your case manager if you qualify for Transitional Funding.
 - What happens once I get released? You should call the main office 208-898-4668 to inform us of your release. Tell us your name and that you want to schedule a time to move-in. You will be given your new address and a time will be set for you to meet your manager at the house.
 - Do I have to worry about there not being a bed available for me once released? No, Rising Sun has many locations.
 - Is there Curfew? Yes. 10:00pm. Exceptions made for work and approval from PnP.
 - Are over-night and weekend passes allowed? Yes, with approval from probation or parole officer.
 - Can I have visitors? No. This is for the safety and security of other residents living in the home.
 - Does Rising Sun allow registered sex offenders? No. However, if you have a sex offense and paroling to Nampa/Caldwell area you may apply to our Riverstone Recovery program by calling 208-985-0052. Riverstone applications can be found on the Rising Sun website's homepage.
 - Are you faith-based? No, but we are a spiritual program that believes faith is a personal choice. Our program is based on the principals of Alcoholics and Narcotics Anonymous. We firmly believe residents should find a program or church that works for them.
 - Will I be charged any additional fee's beyond my rent? No.
 - What happens if I relapse? Residents are usually placed on a 3-day standout (a period of time when you are not allowed to be in the house). To return you would need to report your relapse to parole office and pass a drug test to return.
 - Does the house have Cable, Phone and Internet? Yes
 - Can I have a TV or computer in my room? Yes
 - Are there bunk beds? No
 - How many residents are in a room? Most all rooms are shared with 2 residents.
 - Can I request to move to a different house? Yes
 - Can I request a specific house? Yes
 - Do you supply food? No. Residents apply for food stamps upon release with prison ID.
 - Does Rising Sun issue a rent verification form to verify housing address? Yes upon request.
 - Do you have Laundry facilities? Yes
 - Will I be charged for additional fees for cleaning supplies, laundry soap, toilet paper? No.
 - Is Rising Sun an approved provider with BPA and IDOC? Yes
 - What is the monthly program fee for BPA funded residents? \$80
 - How do most residents find work right away? They network with the other working residents.
 - Are the houses in convenient locations? Yes.
 - Will Rising Sun rent an private apartment to me? Yes. After living at Rising Sun for six months with no relapses and in compliance with probation and parole you would qualify for our Next Step program.



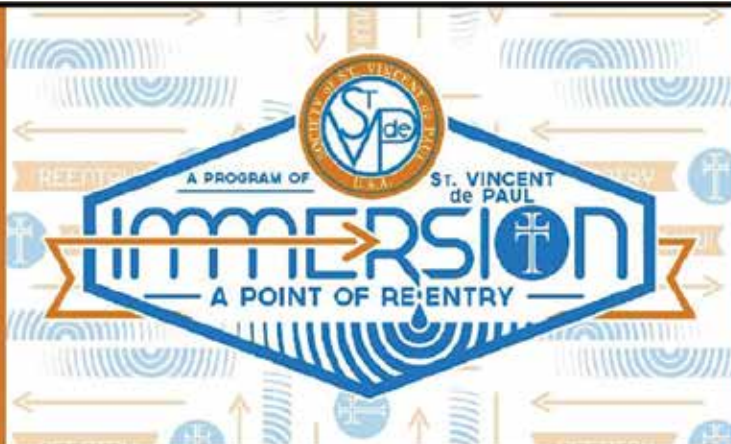

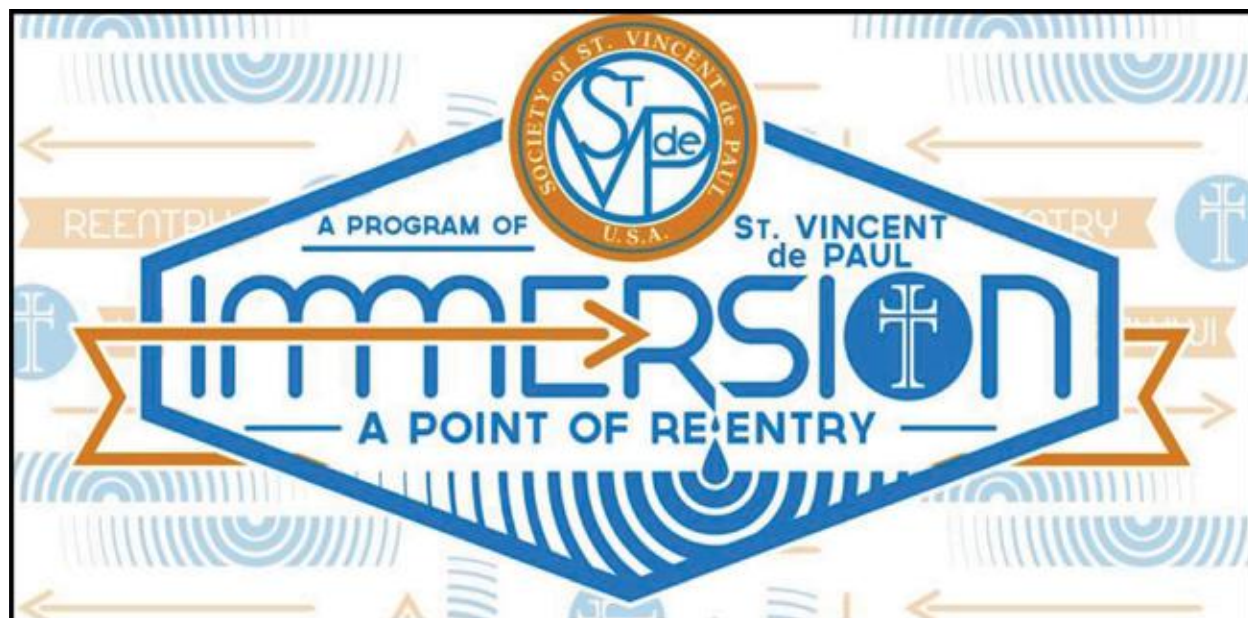
