DINING HALL



The St. Vincent de Paul dining hall is located at 3209 W Overland in Boise. The dining hall serves meals 3-4 times a week. The food is prepared by Chef Sam D'Orazio along with some volunteer chefs and is served by many volunteers. In 2017, the dining hall served up more than 10,000 meals.

Thanks to some grant funding, renovations are taking place to transform the dining hall into a multi-purpose room for educational classes followed by a meal. The renovations include creating sound barriers from the kitchen, food pantry and offices for a quieter informal space. Paint, window coverings, lighting and a large projection screen will complete the multi-use space.

There will be a variety of education classes provided at no cost to anyone who attends. Classes from the "Bridges out of Poverty" concept such as budgeting and money management, Life Skills, Leadership, Nutrition, and Employment Assistance are just a few offerings being planned.
